Discgolf course

Sportland Kõrvemaa Hike and Ski Resort offers maintained disc golf courses. The courses are versatile and suitable for players of any age and skill level. There are two courses: the nine-hole course called 'John Deere' for beginners and the eighteen-hole 'Prodigy Kõrvemaa course' for advanced players. The courses are characteristic of the mountainous landscape of northern Kõrvemaa: they are hilly and challenging, with wide forest corridors.

Format

3 rounds of 21 holes for all players in course Kõrvemaa Prodigy Discgolf Park.

1st round – random mix of player (all divisions together);

2nd round – players grouped by results of 1st round (all divisions together);

3rd round – players grouped by total result of 1st and 2nd rounds and by divisions.

Easy to get to Kõrvemaa Hike and Ski resort

The distance to Estonia's capital Tallinn is only 56km.

By car - follow the Piibe Road and arrive in Tallinn at a distance of about 200 meters in a 31 km post and turn to the left. Then you are in the center of the parking lot.

By bus - ca. 100 m from the center of the new lake bus stop. Bus Line No. 413

Car rental

Tallinn Airport has a number of car rental companies. We recommend to choose our package deal because transport is included.

Journey time

Tallinn Airport to Aegviidu takes around 50 minutes by train. From Aegviidu to hostel takes 15 min by car or bus. Hostel to the arenas takes 15-25 minutes by car or bus.
