

XLIII YEARS BALTIC STATES SPATAKIAD E FOR STUDENTS WITH HEARING PROBLEMS

Swimming competition include competition with Poland-Poznan teams swimmers-2013.

I. THE AIM

1. To promote physical activities and sport as well as to improve sports results among students with hearing problems.
2. To develop international links and friendship among special schools for students with hearing problems in the Baltic States and in the Europe.
3. To reward the best athletes and the best teams on particular sports events.
4. To determine the best athletes among all deaf students.

II. PLACE, TIME AND ORGANISATION OF THE SPARTAKIAD E

1. On 2013. the 43. Years – spartakiade will be settled in Latvia:
On 21.or 22.March till 24. March 2013. in Riga competitions will be in
 - Basketball – men, women
 - Swimming
 - Chess
 - Table tennis
 - Draughts

The day/ time for arriving for participants is on **22.March till 10.00**

The day/ time for departure is on 24 .March at 17.00

P.S. Possibility- arriving time 21.March about 18 00-we inform later.

2. Responsibility for organisation of the Spartakiade is taken by the special Organising Committee that includes members of professional education Institutions and organisations.
3. The regulations of the XLIII Spartakiade for students with hearing problems are drawn based on the “Requirements for organising of the competitions for students with hearing problems in the Baltic States”, accepted on 1983 (supplements made on 1975, 1980 and on 1981).

III. PARTICIPATION

1. An eligible participants for the XLIII Spartakiade are students from Latvia, Estonia and Lithuania who have acceptably good marks at school and without problems of behavior, **who is born 1993. and junger.**

The same regulations are provided also for students with speech difficulties from Special School Nr.1 in Tartu(Estonia). However, the number of students from Tartu can't exceed 25% of the total number of participants from Estonia.

Each student can participate no more than **in two sports events.**

Total number of participants in the team is 39 persons (34 students (17 girls, 17 boys), 4 coaches, 1 chief of the team).

IV. ORGANISATION OF COMPETITIONS

1. Competitions on each sports event are organised by official regulations of the particular sports event are organized by official regulations of the particular sports event.

2. Basketball

Teams are playing in round system. Counting system:

Win – 2 points,

Fail – 1 points,

Reverse – 0 points.

The team having largest amount of points is a **winner team**.

In case of equal amount of points between two possible winner teams, the winner teams is determined by counting of difference in successful and unsuccessful throws during games.

3. Table tennis

Teams are playing in round system.

18 games to be played between two teams: 9 single games for girls, 9 single games for boys. If results is 9:9 ,than need to play -1 pair game for girls, 1 pair game for boys.If

Results is 10:10 , than need to play mix-pair game.

Counting system:

Win – 1 points

Reverse – 0 points.

The team having largest amount of points is a **winner team**. In case of equal amount of points between teams, an additional pair game might be played.

Results of competitions played at home are required to submit at the mandates committee of the Spartakiade.

4. Chess

Teams are playing on rules of the round system.

For reconsideration player can spend 1h.30 min. for 39 moves and then 15 minutes for each move till end of the game.

Counting system:

Win – 1 point,

Fail – 0 points,

Drawn game – 0,5 points.

The team having largest amount of points after all games is a **winner team**. In case of equal amount of points between two, or three teams, the first prize is awarded to the team which has had:

- 1) the most amount of wins,
- 2) the best individual results,
- 3) the best results on the board starting from the first move.

5. Draughts.

Teams are playing on rules of the round system.

For reconsideration player can spend 1h.

Counting system:

Win – 1 point,

Fail – 0 points,

Drawn game – 0,5 points.

The team having largest amount of points after all games is a **winner team**. In case of equal amount of points between two, or three teams, the first prize is awarded to the team which has had:

- 1) the most amount of wins,
- 2) the best individual results,
- 3) the best result on the board starting from the first move.

6. Swimming

Program for both girls and boys:

Free style	100 m	200 m
Breast – stroke	100 m	
Backstroke	100 m	
Relay (free style)	4x100 m	

The team where participants have gathered the most amount of points, is the winner team. In case of the equal amount of points for two or for more teams, the best team is determined by counting of the I-st, II-nd, and III-rd places.

The total result of the team consists of two best results of each team on each event and the result on both relays. Each swimmer can participate no more than in three swimming events and in the relay.

I place – 15 points; II place – 12 points; III – 9; IV – 8 etc. Relay- coefficient-2.

International swimming competition – teams point no scoring.

V. AWARDS.

1. Individual winners will be determined in such sports events as swimming, and table tennis. In others the best teams will be awarded.
2. First three of all participants in individual events will be awarded with diplomas. Participants of winner teams will be awarded with diplomas, too.
Athletes who have performed high results on athletic events, or in swimming will receive individual awards.

Following suggestions of referees, some athletes who have performed good results on other events, could be awarded with souvenirs.

VI. RECEPTION OF PARTICIPANTS.

1. Organization Committee of the XLIII Spartakiade and Special School of Riga for children with hearing impairments will cover all expenses concerning lodging ,meals and competitions organization for all visitors during competitions.
2. Travel expenses must be paid by participant organizations.
3. All participants have to have students identity cards and each team has to have one type of sports dress. Representative of the delegation has to have the list of all team members and license of the doctor.

VII. APPLICATION.

1. The deadline for application for the XLIII Spartakiade for students with hearing impairments is 25.02.2013.
